- Protecting property, keeping order in the event of public disturbances



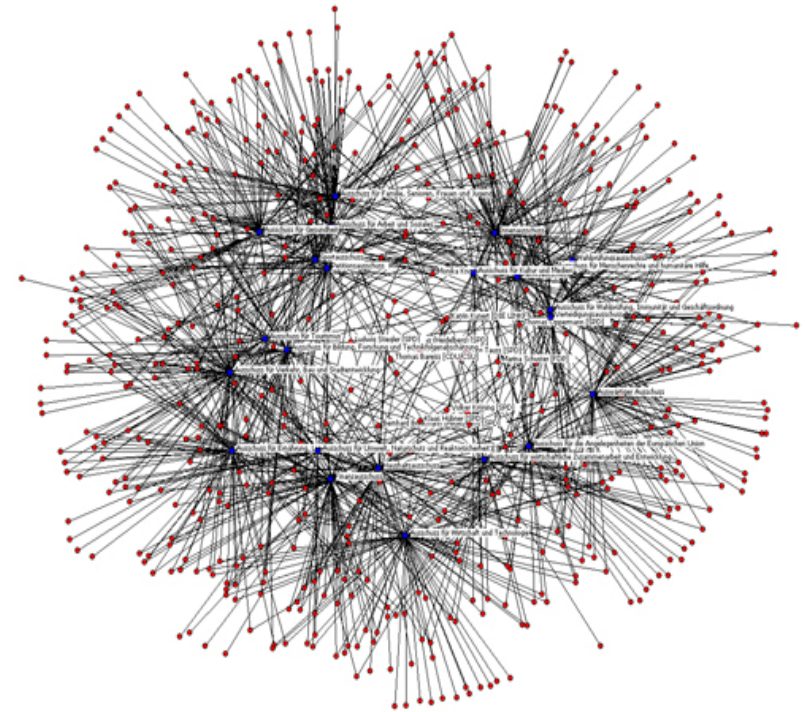
EU in the middle of militant struggles

- "Harmonization" of criminal laws

1999 Tampere

- Creation of a space "freedom, security and justice"
- "Control of migration flows"
- Upgrading Europol
- Creation of "Task Force of European Police Chiefs"



2004 Hague

- Principle of "availability"
- Creation of Frontex
- Data retention
- Expanding data bases
- "Border management"
- Fingerprints while applying for EU-Visa
- Expanding security research



2009 Stockholm

- Under swedish presidency
- November 30/
December 1
- Final decision in Brussels



"Future Group"

- Minister Schäuble with former commissioner of "Justice and Home Affairs", Frattini, founded "Future Group"
- "informal committee" of ministers of interior
- Wrote wishlist for five-year plan

- Cross border remote search
- More control of internet
- More satellite surveillance
- "Risk analysis" via Software
- "e-borders"
- Common deportation flights and planes
- Refugee camps in "third states"



New "five-year plan"

- More police interventions outside Europe
- Enlarging of paramilitary "European Gendarmerie Force"
- Collaboration of inner and outer secret service



Protests against new "five-year plan"

- Sanctions not visible for some years
- Resistance does not overcome national struggle
- 2009 several possibilities of protest
